Zoning

Block 3 – zoned CZ5, for a mandatory use of multi-unit housing (no more than 178 dwellings).

Block 4 – zoned CZ4, for the mandatory use of supermarket, with a minimum GFA of 800m² and a maximum of 1,500m², and multi unit housing of no more than 55 dwellings.

Both blocks also have space for additional, complementary uses – such as café, retail, commercial and community spaces.



Dwelling Yield

Up to 233 diverse residential dwellings.



Affordable Requirements

Approximately 15% of dwellings will need to meet the requirements of the ACT Government's Affordable Home Purchase Scheme.



Whitlam Local Centre is made up of two blocks, which will be sold under one Crown lease to the successful developer.

It will reflect the community's vision, which was developed through a co-design process, for Whitlam Local Centre to be a meeting place for the local community. A place that's inviting and accessible for all, realised through innovative design and high-quality delivery.

Whitlam Local Centre will have active retail frontages facing Alice Moyle Way, the slow-speed main street in the community.

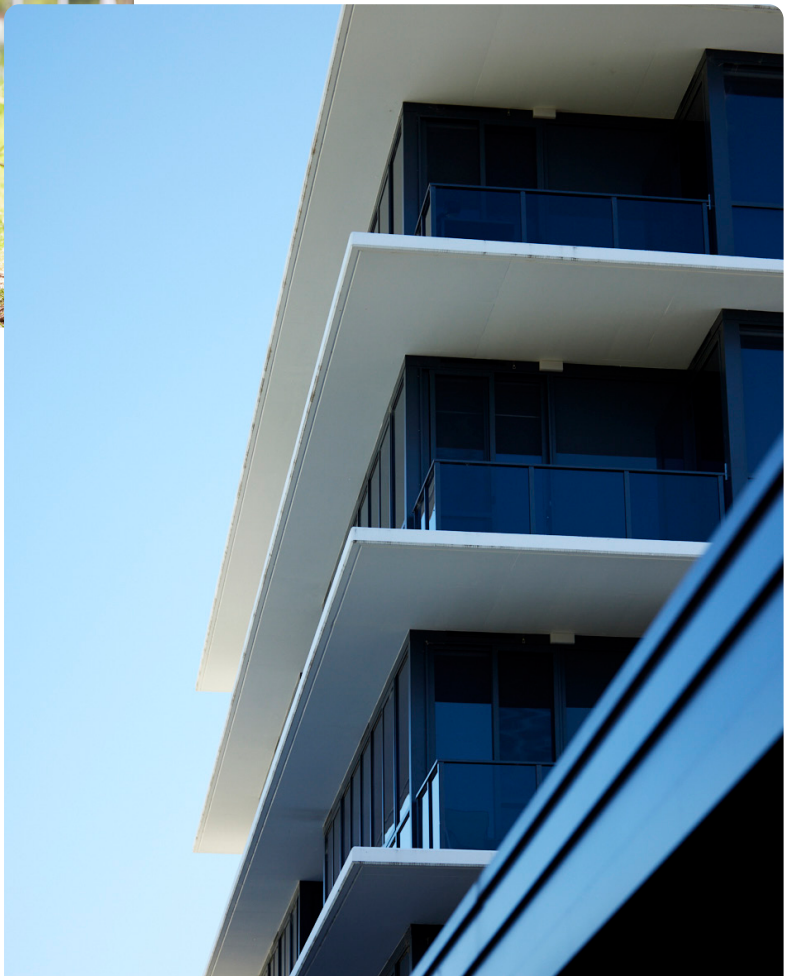
The new ACT Government Primary School is located directly to the east. An anchor supermarket will be located in the southeastern block and a public plaza will create a safe and welcoming connection between the school and the local centre. Above the shops, there will be a range of mixed-use dwellings in buildings of three to six storeys fronting the main street. At ground level, it will offer an integrated, permeable network of well-designed public spaces, paths and streets that support a vibrant public life and high connectivity.

The heart of a growing community

Whitlam sits amongst the rolling hills north of the Molonglo River, less than nine kilometres from Civic. It's surrounded by natural and cultural attractions like the National Arboretum, the Molonglo River Nature Reserve, Mount Stromlo and an extensive network of nature trails.
