CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Eastlake Parade is continuing to change with the installation of an additional entrance to the main car park due to open from December, the remaining section of the road next to the Element development is also now open to traffic. This major road supports traffic travelling north/south through Kingston Foreshore.

Plans are also underway to relocate a sewer odour control unit from its current location beside The Causeway Switching Station (close to Honeysett View), to Kingston Foreshore’s most eastern end on the Peninsula. The unit’s relocation will make way for future precinct land releases.



EXTEND YOUR BRIDGE TO BRIDGE LOOP

Work has begun on the installation of new lights and signage and the upgrade of paths and walkways in Bowen Park, along Lake Burley Griffin’s western edge. From December, walkers and cyclists travelling the popular bridge to bridge loop can look forward to a safer and easily accessible connection under Kings Avenue Bridge to the Kingston Foreshore Promenade.
